Vancouver City Council will hold a Public Hearing on:

**Tuesday, November 16, 2021 at 6:00 pm
to be convened by electronic means**

Council will consider amendments to the Zoning and Development By-law. If approved, the zoning would change from RS-1 (Single-detached Houses and Duplexes) District to RM-8A (Multiple Dwelling) District.

The RM-8A/RM-8AN District Schedule allows:

- stacked townhouses or rowhouses up to three storeys fronting the street.
- a maximum floor space ratio (FSR) of 1.20.

This rezoning application is being considered under the *Cambie Corridor Plan*.
