

Willow Street Access from West 33rd Avenue



As part of this Rezoning Application, an access point from Willow Street linking the campus to the main intersection at 33rd Avenue will be introduced.

- This new entry will provide the primary access from both the south and east and will lead directly to the public arrival point for the BC Women's Hospital.
- A cul-de-sac will be placed at the end of West 32nd Avenue at Willow Street as a traffic calming feature for the residences.
- This new entry will link directly to the perimeter Ring Road system as well as the Wellness Walkway on the site and afford site-wide access for staff and visitors.
- A traffic light signal on West 33rd Avenue will be introduced to improve and alleviate potential traffic and pedestrian congestion from the operations of the Eric Hamber Secondary School and the redevelopment of the St. Vincent's Heather Campus of Care.
- Intersection design at Willow and West 33rd Avenue will be coordinated with the City of Vancouver Engineering Services as per requirements including curbs, bulges and sidewalks.
